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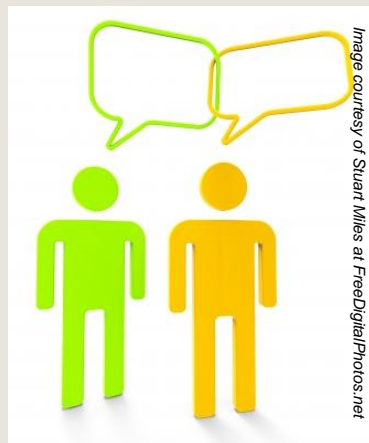
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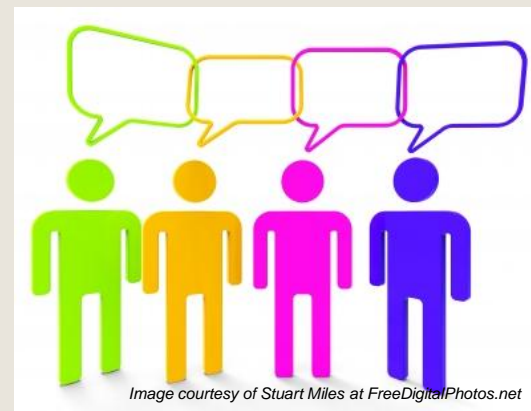

Formal Mentoring

Social Inclusion
Bigger structure
Specific objectives known to all

Takes longer
It's not always voluntary
Bigger pressures concerning time

Informal Mentoring

Satisfied minds
Larger longevity

Possibility of exclusion by stakeholders
