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# Impact of mentoring on students' achievement

- ❖ The studies show that mentoring between teachers has positive impact on students' achievement and general development. In short, the better the teacher, the better the learning outcomes of the students.
- ❖ Obviously, it is hard to link the students' progress directly or only with the fact of their teacher is being mentored, but impact of some activities resulting from mentoring may be clear.
- ❖ Since, it is worth to measure the students performance and observe the results, especially in the long time period.

- Testing, exams and quizzes,
- Grades,
- Activity in the classroom,
- Participation in the projects, competitions, extracurricular activities related to the subject, etc.,
- Percent of class time spent in active learning.

## **MEASURES OF BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDE CHANGE**

- Presence / absence,
- Behaviour towards the teacher and peers,
- Openness / reserve.
