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Impact of mentoring on students' achievement

* The studies show that mentoring between teachers has positive impact on students' achievement and general development. In short, the better the teacher, the better the learning outcomes of the students.

* Obviously, it is hard to link the students' progress directly or only with the fact of their teacher is being mentored, but impact of some activities resulting from mentoring may be clear.

Since, it is worth to measure the students performance and observe the results, especially in the long time period.

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MEASURES OF LEARNING RESULTS:

- Testing, exams and quizes,
- Grades,
- Activity in the classroom,
- Participation in the projects, competitions, extracurricular activities related to the subject, etc.,
- Percent of class time spent in active learning.

MEASURES OF BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDE CHANGE

- Presence / absence,
- Behaviour towards the teacher and peers,
- Openness / reserve.
